



2018 MANO CARNIVALE CAKE STALL *Information Sheet*

Later this week we will be sending home Mano Carnivale cake stall packs (plates, ingredients labels, plastic bags, ties and an instruction sheet) to all of our families.

We would be extremely appreciative, if every family could make/bake a cake, cookies or a slice and donate it to the school to sell on the day of the Mano Carnivale – **Saturday 28 April 2018**. (*please see ideas overleaf*).

In previous years, we have sold out within the first few hours of an event!! In 2018, we are hoping everyone can donate one or two plates of goodies, so that we have something to offer people throughout the day and to also sell items in our 'Mano Café' which will be in a marquee on the Top Terrace.

It is not compulsory to fill all of the plates provided, but if you should fill 1, 2 or more, it would be greatly appreciated. Please note that you can also use other types of packaging, in addition to the ones provided, such as specialty paper boxes, individual cellophane bags *etc*, just as long as it contains the Mano Carnivale Ingredients label.

To ensure we comply with strict food safety and hygiene regulations, below are a couple of reminders when preparing your items for the Cake Stall:

- Please wash your hands prior to food preparation and have your workbench clean and your kitchen free of pets and insects.
- Prior to transporting the products to the school, all cakes, biscuits and slices are to be completely wrapped to prevent contamination from dust and insects.
- Cakes, biscuits and slices that contain or are filled with or covered with cream, yoghurt, cream-cheese or similar products that require refrigeration **are not recommended**.

FOOD LABELING IS IMPORTANT:

Please use the Mano Carnivale Cake Stall label supplied. You can obtain additional labels from the school office should you require more. All items must have a list of ingredients attached to it *or it cannot be sold at the Mano Carnivale*.

There are unfortunately a number of children and adults within the community who suffer from life threatening allergies to foods and their ingredients. So please, carefully and clearly list all ingredients.

Also, if anyone has a **cake stand** (that is not breakable or a family heirloom) for us to use on the day of the carnivale....please label your cake stand and drop it off to the office as soon as possible. You will be able to collect your cake stand on the day of the carnivale after 4pm or from the office the week after the event.

Experience has shown that items sell faster and for a higher price if they are well presented and packaged nicely. All items for the Cake Stall will be priced by us.
