Voluntary Contributions

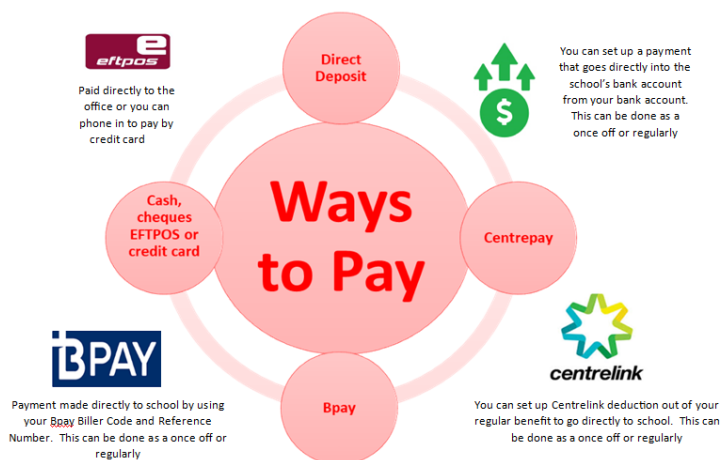
