NEWS FROM MR SMITH

Dear School Community Members,

Mano is a great place to be!: Last Friday, I had the opportunity 7 - 10 to join the Grade 1 Learning Community on their excursion to the Museum of Play and Art (MoPA). Whilst there was much learning that compliments the learning our students have 11-20 engaged in throughout Term 1, I came away from this time with the Grade 1 Learning Community with immense pride. Our students and staff displayed our school values of Respect, Responsibility and Safety, incredible manners were on display and a keen sense of fun was evident. At the conclusion of our time at MoPA, the manager sought me out to praise and admire the behaviour and manner of our students and staff. I congratulate our Grade 1 students and staff for being wonderful Our school provides support and strategies for families to assist ambassadors of our school. Mano is a great place to be!



It's not Okay to be away!: The challenges associated with the pandemic are well publicised. While I acknowledge, understand and recognise the impact the last three years have had on our students, I am confident the Mano community is well placed to navigate our way back to normality. The experts tell us the key to achieving 'normality' is compartmentalising all aspects of "school" and focus on one to two parts. We are currently investing in maximising attendance for all students.

Regular attendance at school plays a vital role for students to achieve their academic potential, as well as setting up a wonderful foundation for their social and emotional development. We hope the table below highlights the importance of regular attendance to school.

How many days will your child miss this year?

This is within the normal range. The child can take advantage of the teaching and learning opportunities available to them, as well develop healthy relationships with peers.

This attendance rate is below average. A child with this attendance rate could miss over one year of schooling between Prep and Year 10.

This is a poor attendance rate. A child with this attendance rate could miss up to two years of schooling between Prep and Year 10.

To miss two years of school between Prep and Year 10 places significant risk on any student. It goes without saying that regular absenteeism from school won't do your child any favours. Allowing your child to skip days simply because they

"don't feel like going to school" should not be an option. regular school attendance. We encourage any family to contact Mrs Mundine or myself to discuss their child's attendance at school.

Dear Parents/Carers,

Change and loss are issues that affect all of us at some stage in

our lives. At Manifold Heights Primary School we recognise that when changes occur in families through death, separation, divorce or related circumstances, young people may benefit from learning how to manage these changes effectively. We are therefore offering a very successful education program called *Seasons for Growth*.

This program is facilitated in small groups and is based on research that highlights the importance of social support and the need to practise new skills to cope effectively with change and loss. The program focuses on issues such as self-esteem, managing feelings, problem solving, decision making, effective communication and support networks.

Seasons for Growth runs for eight weeks and each weekly session is approximately 45 minutes. The program concludes with a 'Celebration' session.

It will commence on **Tuesday 16th May** at 12:30pm and will be facilitated by myself. Be assured I have received special training in the use of this program. Please note there is a **\$14** cost for your child to participate and to receive a **Seasons for Growth Primary Journal**.

If you think your child would benefit from *Seasons for Growth* we would encourage you to talk to him/her first about this. Child voice and agency in the process is very important. [Please note it is recommended that one sibling attend]. Should your child decide to participate please fill in the tear-off section below and return to the school office by **Thursday 6th April**, along with the **\$14** journal fee.

Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge

The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge is now open and Manifold Heights Primary School is excited to be participating. The PRC application offers a range of exciting features including:

- access to a library catalogue (including book images and blurbs)
- · a modern user-friendly interface
- rewarding students with badges as challenge milestones are achieved
- the option for students to mark books as a favourite, give them a star rating or complete a book review

The Challenge is open to all Victorian children from birth to Year 10 in recognition of the importance of reading for literacy development. It is not a competition; but a personal challenge for children to read a set number of books by 8th September 2023.

Children from Prep to Year 2 are encouraged to read or 'experience' 30 books with their parents and teachers. Children from Year 3 to Year 10 are challenged to read 15 books.

All children who meet the Challenge will receive a certificate of achievement signed by the Victorian Premier and former Premiers.

We look forward to seeing Mano getting involved and raising money for this valued organisation. Thank you to our Mano Junior School Council for their hard work in preparing this fabulous event!






