I really loved Art. I loved being creative and getting into all the colours and line work. I once painted a running shoe with streaks of paint!



# **Learning About our Breath!**

Throughout the term, students have been focusing on their breath. Deep 'belly' breathing is known to relax and reduce stress in the body and mind. To encourage students to take long, slow breaths, we refer to the following: **Smell the flower**. **Blow up the balloon**.

There are many opportunities for students to use this strategy. This may be throughout the week including: twice daily mindfulness sessions or as part of their co-developed 'Ready to Learn Plans'. Ready to Learn Plans are a set of coping strategies, or tools, that students can rely on if they are ever feeling as though they are not 'ready to learn'.

Over the holidays you and your child/ren might like to practise some deep belly breathing. You might like to use the linked <u>template</u> (just like Clem from 1A, pictured) to colour and decorate your own Breathe Board.





Or, you may like to use the example (right) from The Resilience Project.

You can find the link for it here.

Breathe boards provide a visual and a path for your finger to follow to practice a mindful moment. This allows you to be present and filter out any other distractions.

There is no cost for a Volunteer Working with Children Check (a passport photo is required). Please ask at the General Office if you need a hand – we look forward to seeing our students continue to benefit from the amazing work that parents/guardians do as volunteers at our school. Please check with your local post office if they process Working with Children Checks.

## Re: Invitation to attend group



Dear Parents/Carers,

Change and loss are issues that affect all of us at some stage in

our lives. At Manifold Heights Primary School we recognise that when changes occur in families through death, separation, divorce or related circumstances, young people may benefit from learning how to manage these changes effectively. We are therefore offering a very successful education program called *Seasons for Growth*.

This program is facilitated in small groups and is based on research that highlights the importance of social support and the need to practise new skills to cope effectively with change and loss. The program focuses on issues such as self-esteem, managing feelings, problem solving, decision making, effective communication and support networks.

**Seasons for Growth** runs for eight weeks and each weekly session is approximately 45 minutes. The program concludes with a 'Celebration' session.

It will commence on **Tuesday 16th May** at 12:30pm and will be facilitated by myself. Be assured I have received special training in the use of this program. Please note there is a **\$14** cost for your child to participate and to receive a **Seasons for Growth Primary Journal**.

If you think your child would benefit from *Seasons for Growth* we would encourage you to talk to him/her first about this. Child voice and agency in the process is very important. [Please note it is recommended that one sibling attend]. Should your child decide to participate please fill in the tear-off section below and return to the school office by **Thursday 6**<sup>th</sup> **April**, along with the **\$14** journal fee.


